1. Scholarship Application (3 pages)
2. Transcript of high school grades. Transcript should indicate class rank/class size and test scores. Transcript should also list courses being taken at the 12<sup>th</sup> grade level.
3. List activities (clubs, athletics, musical interests, hobbies, etc.) in which you have been involved including work experience and community service.



4. List awards, honors or special recognitions you have received from the school and/or community. (Please attach a separate sheet)
5. In 500 words or less please answer the following question: (Please attach a separate sheet)

*“How will your high school experiences including academic, work and community service benefit your college community? “*

6. Dated, signed letters of recommendations from at least one but not more than two persons in authority (ex. Teachers, Advisors, Coaches) from the high school you now attend who are familiar with your work. Letter may cover the applicant’s ability, work habits, integrity and potential.
7. Applicant may be notified when application is received by the Chapter if an email is provided by applicant.
8. Winner(s) will be notified as soon as scholarship is awarded but no later than April 15<sup>th</sup>.
9. Application MUST be signed to be considered.
